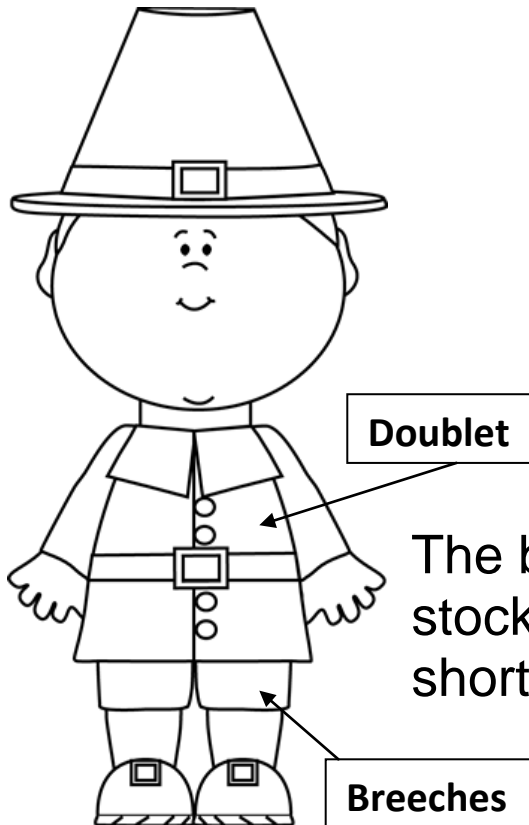
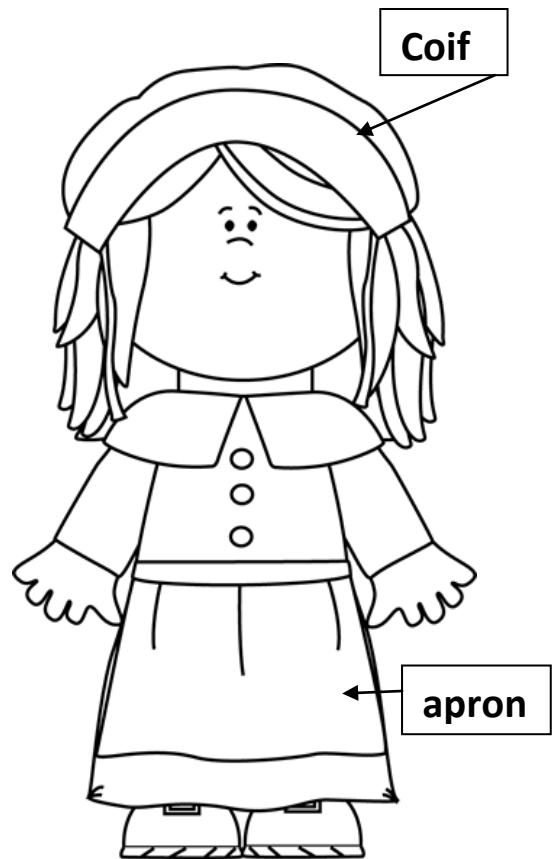


Pilgrim Clothing

The pilgrims wear many layers of clothing.

The girls wear petticoats, skirts, blouses, coats, boots, and stockings. They also wear a coif on their heads and an apron.



The boys wear breeches, stockings and boots. They wear a short coat called a doublet.

There are no sewing machines so the clothes are made by hand and colored with things the pilgrims find in the New World (plants, animals, minerals).
