

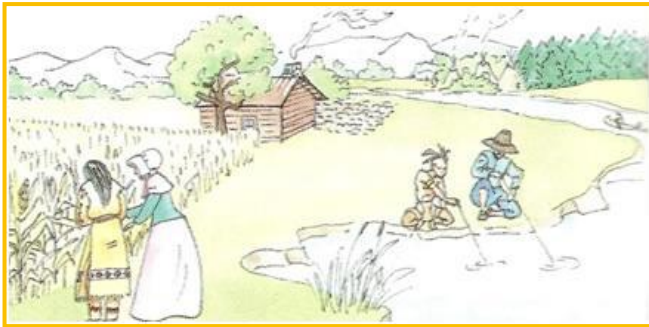
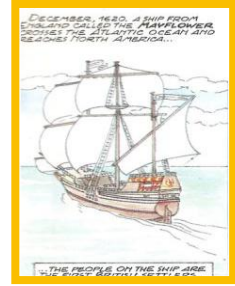


THE STORY OF THANKSGIVING

They land at Plymouth Rock, in what is now Massachusetts.

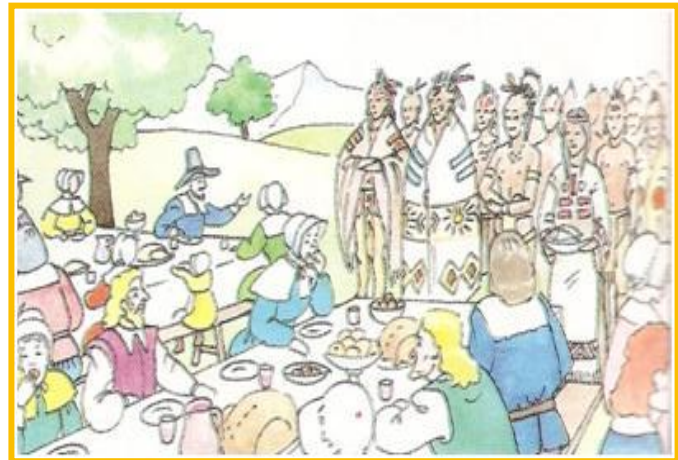
The first winter is very hard. They have little food. It is very cold! Many Pilgrims got sick. Many die.
