

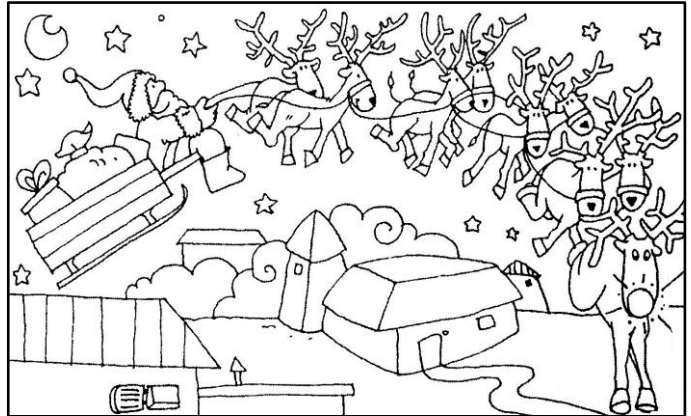


# Christmas in England

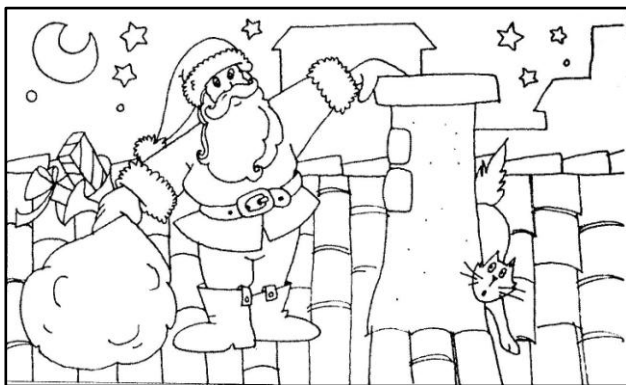
Read:

In England children get the presents from Father Christmas.

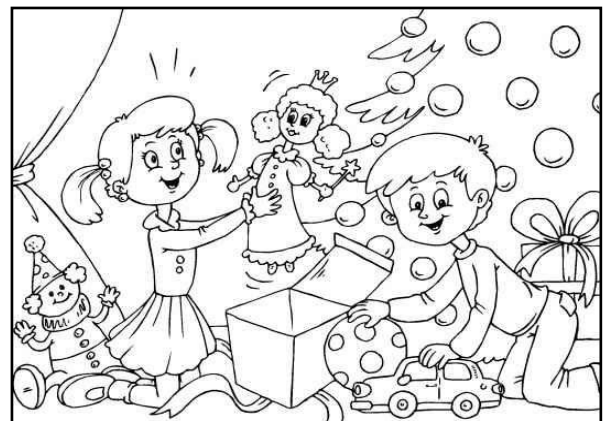

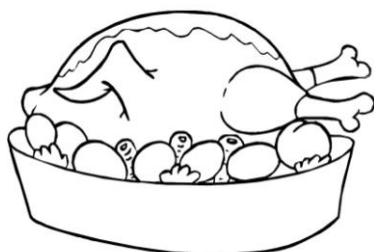
Santa and his reindeer land on the roofs of the houses and Santa comes down the chimney, leaving the presents in the stockings hanging around the fireplace or at the children's beds.
