



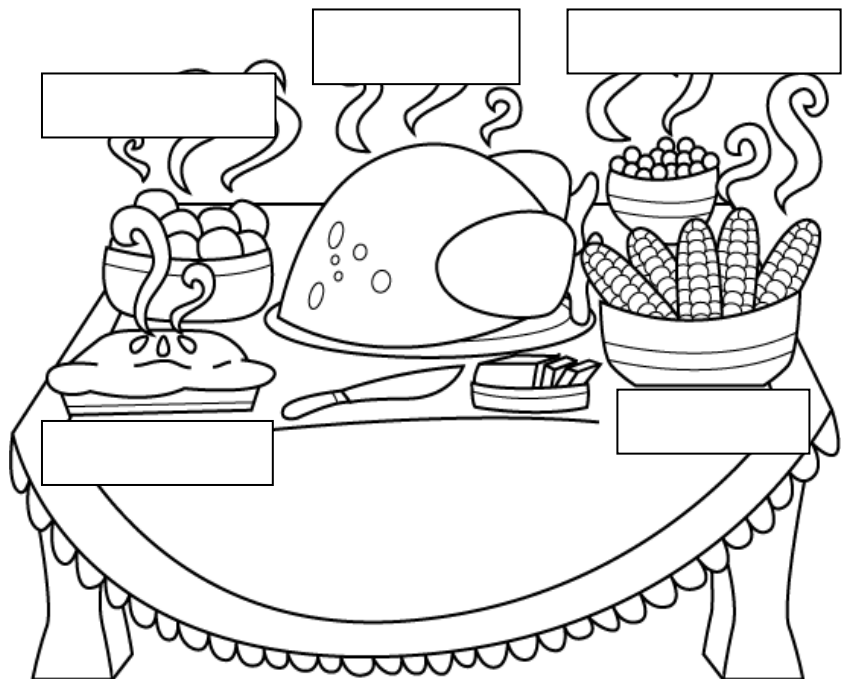
Philip's Thanksgiving Day
